Pillar Collaborate:

Collaboration will be fostered by:

- a) Spending three days with fellow ecosystem players
- b) Europe's leading interdisciplinary technology festival
- c) Participants feel inspired and build a network in Berlin and beyond


MEET THE BERLIN ECOSYSTEM DAY 1




MEET THE BERLIN ECOSYSTEM DAY 2






